the seven youths at the Martyr's
Memorial, Patna;
the 50 paisa stamp, launched in
1983 depicting the
day in 1942 when
the All India Congress
Committee passed a
Quit India Resolution; and 1 and
2 rupees stamps issued
in 1992 to mark 50 years of the
"Guit India Resolution."
It also has four commemoratives coins of ₹1, 10, 50
and 100 issued by
the Reserve Bank of India in
1992 to celebrate
the golden jubilee of the Quit
India Movement.
