## DOCUDRAMA TO RECALL 'QUIT INDIA'

Mumbai: On the 75th Anniversary of the Quit India Movement, [www.mintageworld.com](http://www.mintageworld.com) on Monday will launch a docudrama on the history of the various stamps, coins and notes minted to celebrate the spirit of Indian patriotism and the freedom struggle.

Some of the unique stamps and coins launched to celebrate the occasion are the 15 paise stamp, launched on October 1, 1967 depicting a life-size statue of the seven youths at the Martyr's Memorial, Patna; the 50 paise stamp, launched in 1983 depicting the day in 1942 when the All India Congress Committee passed a Quit India Resolution; and 1 and 2 rupees stamps issued in 1992 to mark 50 years of the "Quit India Resolution."

It also has four commemorative coins of ₹1, 10, 50 and 100 issued by the Reserve Bank of India in 1992 to celebrate the golden jubilee of the Quit India Movement.
